Hello Bikers and Habitat for Humanity Supporters:

We hope that you saved the date, May 4th, for Greater Fredericksburg Habitat for Humanity's 12th annual RIDE VIRGINIA 19 Poker Run. This is a "rain or shine" event. However, if you don't like the weather or can't make the Ride, you can draw and play your hand at the GFHFH ReStore or Cowboy Jack's.

The registration fee is still \$25 for the rider and \$20 for the playing passenger. Each **pre-registered** participant is guaranteed a poker hand, Ride T-shirt, Ride patch and/or bar, ticket for a meal at Cowboy Jack's, Goodie bag and door prize drawing ticket. You can preregister for the Poker Run online by going to our website at www.fredhab.org, click on the "Events" tab and go to "Poker Run." Or you can still register at the event on the day of the Ride.

If you need a T-shirt size larger than 2X, you should pre-register online so we are able to order the T-shirt and have it for you on the day of the Ride at the GFHFH ReStore.

Ride Day will start on May 4th at 9:00 am at the GFHFH ReStore, 2378 Plank Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22401, next to Gold's Gym and will end at Cowboy Jack's across the parking lot from the ReStore. We will again have a group led ride with trained road captains departing at 10:00 in the morning. If you prefer, you can still ride by yourself or with a group of your friends.

Hello everyone,

Spring is finally here. For many that means getting the bike out of winter storage or for some of us that ride in the winter it means that we get to ride more often. Regardless of whether we rode our motorcycles a little or not at all during the winter the undisputed fact is that our skills get rusty and we need to get our riding skills back into peak condition. So, the topic of this months safety is PRACTICE, PRACTICE.

Let's use the GWRRA Rider Courses as a model for practicing our skills. Remember that we divide our skills into "mental" proactive skills and "physical" proactive skills. We want to be proactive and not reactive. Being reactive often results in bad outcomes. Also remember that about 80% of riding involves "mental" skills and if we apply them correctly, we avoid the need to use some "physical" skills to avoid an accident.

Mental Skills

Practice using your senses, especially your eyes to gather information to predict what may happen.

- Use the Seek, Anticipate, Act model to avoid potential issues.
 - Seek by scanning aggressively, especially at intersections.
 - Anticipate what other drivers may do.
 - Act to avoid issues by adjusting speed, direction or by communicating to other drivers.
- Use the 12-4-2-rule
 - Scan 12 seconds ahead to identify potential problems.
 - o If an issue is only 4 seconds ahead it may require immediate action, BE READY!
 - 2 second is about all the time you will have to execute any evasive action to avoid an accident. Are you ready for that?

Physical Skills

Practice Braking, Cornering and Swerving. These are the skills we lack or lose due to not practicing. DON'T WAIT until the accident is about to happen to find out whether you still have the needed skills to avoid the crash.

- Go to a parking lot and practice controlled and sudden braking. Remember Straighten, Square and Squeeze from your rider course?
- Practice Cornering, both slow maneuvers in a parking lot and fast corners out on the road. Remember Slow, Look, Press and Roll?
- Do you remember how to swerve quickly to avoid an obstacle? Do you remember "push" steering or "counter" steering?

If you have forgotten any of the terms used above or you have never heard them before maybe you should consider taking a rider course. Just because the Levels Program only requires you to take a course every three years is that enough to keep your skills in peak condition? Only you can answer that question.

Speaking of Rider Courses, there are still a couple of openings in the ARC Course on April 27 th and the TRC Course on May 11 th . Both courses are in Roanoke at the Blue Ridge Hotel and Conference Center (Same location as Rally In The Valley). Email me at leroygross@outlook.com if you are interested.

Also: the Trailer Course (for bike and trailer) and the Trike and Trailer Course being offered at Rally In The Valley this year. PLEASE, PLEASE take advantage of these opportunities to develop or maintain your riding skills.

Other News

Many of you have taken the Medic First Aid Course recently as there have been many offerings in the District recently. Some of you take CPR/AED/First Aid at other places and receive credit toward your levels in the Levels Program. National has recently published an official list of what courses are acceptable in lieu of the GWRRA Medic First Aid Course.

The following are accepted as long as it includes "hands on" training:

- American Red Cross
- American Safety Health Institute
- Buddy Care Air Force First Responder
- Canadian Red Cross
- Emergency Medical Services (Medical Doctor Nurse EMT, or First Responder)
- Heart and Stroke Foundation of Canada
- National Safety Council
- St. Johns Ambulance


