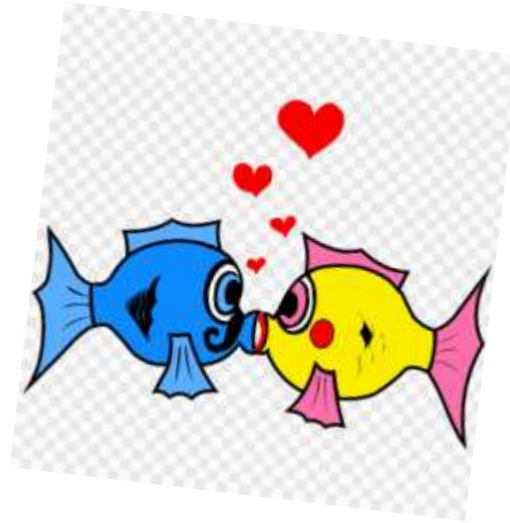

Tech Tips *from the Webmaster*

So I finally took the plunge and bought an Apple Watch Ultra because I wanted something different from the regular Apple Watch Series 8. Mostly because of the larger screen, a Titanium case, and the ECG capability. I am a heart patient (Atrial Fibrillation) and the ECG and heartrate features are extremely handy. I use the ECG on a daily basis and where I can share the data with my cardiologist at my next appointment. The data is automatically saved to your iPhone for easy reading.

Another cool feature is the workout tracker. So when I was recently in Colorado Springs, I took an impromptu hike and my Apple Watch automatically detected I was in the middle of a workout. It would then occasionally ask me if I still wanted to log the information as I went along. It then logged and saved my hike information, all the way down to the elevation gain. Once your workout has completed, the data is also automatically saved to your iPhone. Maybe one day I will make it back to the gym and have more to brag about, but I believe it will help me get motivated to return. There are a ton of apps that will keep track of and aid you with your workouts so make sure you explore these options to find the one that works best for you.



Other cool features that you may not know about include a blood oxygen meter, a depth meter for all you SCUBA divers, and crash detection. Yes, it can actually tell when you've been in a car crash. Let's say you were in a car accident and knocked unconscious to where you cannot call EMS. Apple Watch Ultra will automatically call emergency services if you do not respond to the prompt. Definitely a lifesaving feature that you want out of a watch, especially for all motorcycle riders.

Other features like a sleep app, a soothing mindful app, and a watch that has the ability to make and receive phone calls WITHOUT having to use your iPhone, right on your wrist. I believe the latter feature is only an \$8 monthly charge on Verizon Wireless. If you've ever considered using a smart watch, at least consider this, the Apple Watch Ultra. MANY more features for you to experience and customize and express yourself.

Oh, be sure to make the watch face your own!

Safe Group Riding

I have accepted the position of Safety Officer with the Battlefield Wings. As such, the articles I write for the monthly newsletter will be focused on riding safety. This month I would like to focus on the pre-ride meeting.



Battlefield Wings schedules group rides fairly often, usually once a week weather permitting. The riders that show up are sometimes but not always the same. Sometimes someone shows up that hasn't ridden with the group for a while or maybe someone shows up that has never ridden with the group. So, what does everyone need to know to help keep all the riders in the group safe? This should be covered in the pre-ride meeting usually conducted by the person who is leading the ride.

The following is a list of topics to be covered in the pre-ride meeting. It is based on concepts of the old GWRRA curriculum (of which most of us are familiar) and the Motorcycle Safety Foundation.

- Basic description of the route, rest stops, fuel stops and any known hazards.
- Who will lead and who will sweep (also known as tail or drag).
- Will there be one group or multiple groups (try to keep groups to 7 or less)
 - If multiple groups assign a lead and sweep for each group.
- Explain staggered formation, single file and the hand signs for each.
- How will communication take place during the ride (CB, Bluetooth mesh, hand signals or combination of communication methods).
- Is anyone leaving the group during the ride.
 - Place them in front of the sweep for less disruption of the group.
- What is the plan if the group gets separated (intersections, traffic)
- What is the plan if there is an emergency, broken motorcycle etc.
 - Goal is to get as many as possible out of a hazardous area.
- Any individual concerns within the group (medical, riding skill, mechanical issue)
 - Provide an opportunity for this to be expressed privately.

Hopefully covering these topics in the pre-ride meeting helps keep the group ride safe for everyone.

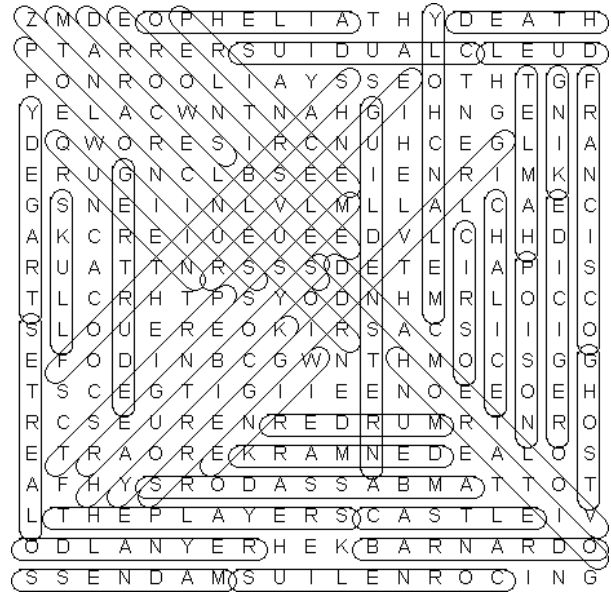
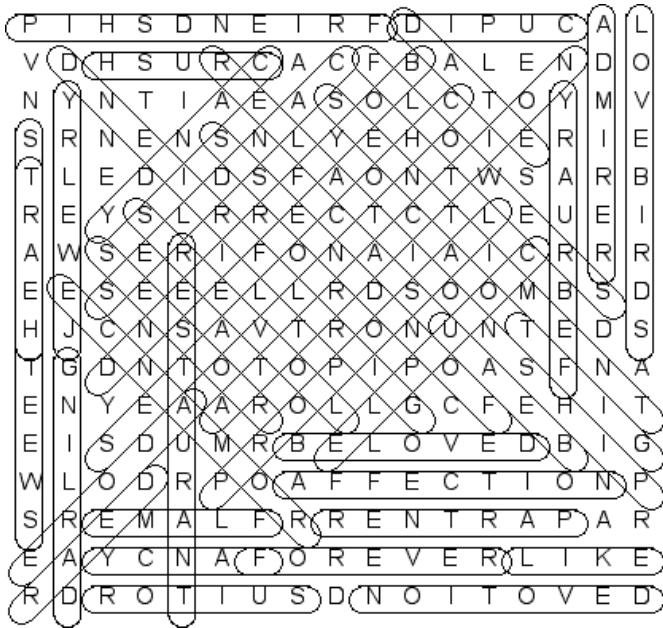
