## How To Avoid Getting Rear-Ended

I received this article from a friend about how to avoid getting rear-ended. Many of the concepts are talked about in the Advanced Rider Course that many of us have taken while in GWRRA but worth reviewing.



On the racetrack, not using mirrors might be a good idea, while riding on the street, mirrors are absolutely crucial – especially when stopped at an intersection, when you could have a distracted driver coming up fast from behind. It takes more than working brake lights to keep from becoming a hood ornament on that big Dodge Ram that didn't have enough "Dodge" and had too much "Ram"!

Here are some tips that can help you avoid an unplanned Life Flight ride: As you're slowing down to stop at a red light, stop sign, or whatever – check your mirrors to see if the traffic behind you is also slowing down. Touch the brakes a few times to flash your brake lights and be especially alert if you're going to stop when a light turns yellow, because the guy behind you might be expecting you to blast straight through it. While I'm not at all a fan of running a yellow, it could be the best course of action, if it becomes obvious that the driver behind you seems to be planning to run it and mow down anything in his path!

Now that you're safely stopped, be ready to get going again in an instant – just in case Ricky Racer wants to share the same piece of real estate you're occupying. If it seems like you're in imminent danger of becoming intimate with a speeding car – get a move on! Where you position your bike can vary depending on the situation – but stay off the road grime that accumulates in the center of the lane, stay in gear, and scan your mirrors and the other traffic around you. With all the things you need to be watching out for, being the first one in line at a red light should keep you busier than a long-tailed cat in a room full of rocking chairs.

Always have an evacuation plan in mind, just in case the car behind you gets too big, too fast. If you're behind another vehicle, stop far enough back to give yourself room to quickly maneuver around it if necessary. If your front tire is only inches off its bumper, you won't be able to avoid becoming the meat in a 4-wheeler sandwich. Always be aware of other traffic coming from any other direction so you don't avoid one accident just to create another. Your escape route might not always look pretty, but if you need to use it, I can promise you that it's most likely a far cry better than what the alternative could be.

In addition to where you position yourself, the equipment on your bike can also help tip the scales in your favor. Always keep your mirrors clean and adjusted properly, and if all you can see in them is your arm, get mirror extenders so you can see what you need to see behind you. Check all your lights often, and if you add flashing brake lights, keep them far enough away from your rear turn signals so your intentions are clearly understood.

#### **Quick Facts:**

Research by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) revealed that of all rear-end collisions involving a motorcycle and a car, the car driver was at fault 29% of the time, and that the motorcycle rider was the guilty party who hit the car in 68% of those rear-enders! Something to think about here is that statistically, we're even more oblivious than they are! Maybe the next time the topic of "Motorist Awareness" comes up – since we who ride are to blame for most of the ugly stuff that happens out there, it might be good to remember that primarily, we're the "motorists" who need to increase our "awareness" of others.

### Motorcyclists Information From General Assembly

### Pressure Mounts on Federal Government to Act on Self-Driving Cars

Late last week it was announced that Tesla will recall 362,000 vehicles equipped with its Full Self-Driving (FSD) Beta software. This comes after U.S. regulators said on Thursday the driver assistance system did not adequately adhere to traffic safety laws and could cause crashes. The recall comes on the heels of a string of crashes last summer involving motorcyclists in Florida, Utah, and California.

In the announcement the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) said that the software reportedly may not respond sufficiently to posted speed limits and may cause cars to drive through intersections in an "unlawful or unpredictable manner."

NHTSA noted that the software may cause Tesla owners to travel straight through an intersection in a turn-only lane, fail to come to a complete stop at a stop sign, or drive through a yellow light "without due caution."

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) has long been concerned about the deployment of these vehicles without proper testing. Additionally, it seems that consumers have a false sense of security when driving these vehicles, are not aware of what the vehicles true capabilities are, and don't understand they must remain alert and engaged in the operation of the vehicle. Just two months ago the MRF worked with congressional leaders seeking answers from NHTSA about this new technology and how it interacts with motorcyclists. Pressure is also being applied by state motorcyclist rights organizations. ABATE of Wisconsin will be using their "Lobby Day" in Madison to take aim at rules and regulations on self-driving cars in their state. ABATE of Indiana and ABATE of Illinois remain focused on this battle in Indianapolis and Springfield. A growing number of other states are also taking

up the battle to protect the safety of motorcylists as it relates to this new technology.

While the MRF and state groups remain vigilant in our fight to protect you as a biker, as always, you should remain alert of all other roadway users.
