
Chapter Director



Chapter Rider's Education

strategies to live by from Larry



Keith's Experience

Years ago I was talking with Keith Hill and he told me about a scary part of a ride. I wrote about his recollections in this column back in '06 or '07 but I've decided to discuss it again. It is short and sweet.

Keith was traveling along Route 3 in front of the Stafford Wal Mart. There is an intersection there and he had a green light. Traffic was very light and he observed that there were no "threats" at the intersection (no oncoming left turners, cross traffic at the light was dutifully waiting for the light to change) so he started a smooth acceleration to resume cruising speed. He also started a lane change. To his surprise, he felt the rear wheel lose traction. He eased off the gas but felt a full fishtail cycle before things returned to normal. No crash or injury, just an unsettling surprise severe enough to really get his attention.

After Keith told me the story, I went to the intersection (now days later) to see if there was an unusual amount of oil drippings or sand or something that could explain what happened. I did see what looked like the remnants of a significant spill of some kind but it was only a stain at that point, nothing that would compromise traction. So, what really happened is a mystery. It could have been diesel fuel, antifreeze, sand, or something else. We'll never know.

What can we learn from this? We can't be sure what caused the loss of traction and we can't tell whether Keith should have been able to see the trouble before riding into it. We can't fault him for overaggressive acceleration (he said he was going about 45 so he would have probably been in fourth gear) or overaggressive steering (he was only changing lanes and it was the rear tire that broke traction).

Maybe what we can learn is that getting a little time on a dirt bike where losses of traction are common would be beneficial even to Goldwing riders. Dirt bike experience would develop some appropriate reflexes and would be worthwhile even if we had no intention to getting into this as a sport (I'm ready for this!).

If nothing else, we can be reminded that sometimes the unexpected will happen. Sometimes out of the blue. When it does, we will be very thankful that we dressed for the fall rather than for the ride. Wear your gear – for every ride.

(Maybe our gear should include an extra change of underwear – I didn't ask Keith if he needed that.)

Position Description

Purpose

The Membership Enhancement Coordinators main purpose is the retention of Members. Coordinators will also work with Directors at each level to promote FUN activities for the Members. They will work with the Directors to educate the Membership on the many benefits of being a GWRRA Member (i.e. Gold Book, Wing World, Rescue Program, etc...) and make sure all the New and Prospective Members are contacted on a monthly basis when the Area Report List is sent out from the Home Office.

Chapter Level

Responsibilities:

- Develop and maintain a Membership listing for the Chapter from the Gathering sign-in sheet and provide support for the Chapter Director.
- Be responsible for the sign-in sheet at Chapter Gatherings making sure everyone signs in and checking Membership expiration dates.
- Work with the Chapter Director and Team to promote Chapter activities and FUN events for the Members.

- Promote changes positively to help keep politics away from the Membership.
- Be a mentor to New Members (explain the benefits of GWRRA, the terminology, Chapter Life, etc...).
- Promote involvement within the Membership and encourage everyone to become involved.
- Gather and/or write articles for Chapter Newsletter.
- May be asked to serve on the Couple of the Year selection committee.
- May be asked to serve as the Chapter of the Year Coordinator.

Two More Bills Filed that are of Interest to Motorcyclists January 6, 2014

Two more bills were filed that, while not directly aimed at motorcyclists, are of interest to us. Both Bills were filed by Senator Jeff McWaters who represents parts of Virginia Beach. VCOM will be watching both bills closely.

The first is bill is SB 179. It concerns mopeds which, while not motorcycles, seem to be a topic that is of interest to many motorcyclists. This bill would require operators of mopeds to be 16 years of age or older, and to possess and carry a valid driver's license. It also classifies mopeds as motor vehicles. Currently, mopeds are not considered motor vehicles for most purposes. The major impact that such a re-classification would have is that an owner would be required to carry motor vehicle liability insurance on their moped unless they paid the yearly \$500 uninsured motor vehicle fee. This will be interesting to watch. I will follow up with any additional news on this bill as it makes its way through the legislative process.

The other bill is SB 180. For those of you who are age 75 or older, or those of you who are close, this bill will be of particular interest to you. The bill reduces the age at which a driver must appear before the DMV in order to renew their driver's license from 80 to 75. It also provides that drivers who are age 75 or older may not renew their license for more than five years.

1 stick of butter


